Students and Employers,

Registration for the 2021-2022 school year is in progress. Enclosed are the registration form and directions to school locations. Additional information can be found at www.mykyma.org. Information has been mailed to students of record previously enrolled in the 2020-2021 school year. *Registration must be received at the above address by 7/29/2021 with payment in full. Registration forms received without payment in full will not be accepted.*

Tuition rates for 2021-2022 as follows: Full-time enrollment (1 night per week) is \$1,800.00 for the entire school year (both semesters). Any student needing to make up a class will be required to pay for that class according to the class time required. For a ½ year class or ½ night per week, tuition will be \$900. For a ¼ year course, tuition will be \$450.00. Methods of payment are personal and company check only. Checks should be made payable to the "Kentuckiana Machining Association". No refunds can be issued after the first night of class.

Previous Post Secondary Education Transcripts: Student transcripts must be received at the above address no later than 07/16/2021 for consideration for credit towards the KMA program. Transcripts received after that date will not be accepted.

The attendance policy for the 2021-2022 school year is the same as last year. In order for a student to receive a certificate of completion from the Kentuckiana Machining Association, classroom attendance is required. Therefore, no excused absences will be granted for any reason. For each class missed, student's final grade will be reduced by 4 points. Furthermore, a student will not pass a class if they miss more than 15% of the required class meeting hours. Minimum attendance requirements will be given to each student the first week of classes.

School locations: Southern High School and Jeffersontown High School. See enclosed registration form for location by class.

College Credit Hours can be awarded to students who choose to further their education and enroll at Jefferson Community Technical College Louisville Campus to pursue an associate's degree in machining or a related area of study. Based on the current agreement between the Kentuckiana Machining Association and Jefferson Community Technical College up to 48 credit hours can be awarded to the student at no cost (except for JCTC admission fee). Upon completion of the KMA program and acceptance to JCTC Jefferson Campus credit hours would be transferred directly into JCTC. An associate's degree from JCTC typically requires 67-72 credit hours, up to 48 hours already earned through the KMA.
